An Act

To amend the Hazardous Materials Transportation Act to authorize appropriations for fiscal year 1979.

Sept. 30, 1978
[S. 1896]

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, That section 115 of the Hazardous Materials Transportation Act (49 U.S.C. 1812) is amended by—

- (1) striking out “and” immediately after “1976,”; and
- (2) inserting “, and not to exceed \$5,000,000 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1979” immediately after “1978”.
